PER ERIE COUNTY FAIRGROUNDS MANAGEMENT: NO SHOWING OFF THE TRAILER IS ALLOWED ON THE SHOWGROUNDS. ALL HORSES ON THE SHOWGROUNDS AT THE CANDY APPLE MUST PURCHASE AND BE HOUSED IN A STALL, NO EXCEPTIONS.

Entries will be accepted at the show up to one hour before the class. You must see the show office to receive your number and pay your fees.

## **REGISTRATION**

All classes are open to horses registered with AQHA, except that horses of any breed may complete in the following classes: WNYQHCI Open Showmanship Sweepstakes, Open Trail Stake, Open Hunter Stake and Lead Line.

## **REFUNDS**

No refunds on campers, stalls, or entries without a current Vet Certificate presented BEFORE the start of the show. Vet Certificates may be faxed. Time stamp on vet certificate will be determining factor on faxed certificates.

Package deals are non-refundable unless current Vet Certificate is presented BEFORE the start of the show. See above.

## **PAYBACKS**

All payback classes will be paid back on a percentage basis of the entry fees for that class.

Payback checks will be mailed after the show, provided that all checks for entry payments, stalls, and campers have cleared the bank. Any money owed to WNYQHCI for any reason will be deducted from the purse money paid out.

TIES: The judge whose last name is last in the alphabet will be the tie-breaker judge.

## **MISCELLANEOUS**

Per Town of Hamburg ordinance, all dogs must be contained or on a leash at all times.

WNYQHCI is not responsible for lost, damaged, or stolen articles or injury to horses, exhibitors or spectators.

WNYQHCI Officers, Show Secretary and/or Show Manager reserve the right to expel exhibitors who demonstrate unsportsmanlike conduct and/or inhumane treatment of horses and will report cases of abuse to the authorities and to AQHA and in accordance with AQHA's Statement of Position on Animal Welfare.
